



Document Certification 4.0 Release Notes

July 7, 2016

Effective **July 14, 2016**, the Document Certification 4.0 release will be implemented with key changes to enhance the user experience. Changes associated with this release include:

- User interface enhancements
- Retirement of the 2000-character file format as an option for exporting data from Document Certification

User Interface Enhancements

With this release, the following enhancements will be implemented in the Document Certification user interface:

- Improved clarity and organization of Fannie Mae and Document Certification logos.
- The calendar feature on various screens will be updated as detailed below:
 - The calendar on the Certification Management screen will allow users to view past and future months, and select the beginning and ending dates for the following fields:
 - Submitted Date Range
 - Certified Date Range
 - Settlement Date Range
 - The calendar on the New Certification Detail screen will display past and future months, and allow users to select an appropriate date for the Pool Issue Date field.
- The export functionality on both the Certification Management and Certification Detail screens, will be updated to enable users to export data more efficiently.

NOTE: All the user interface findings apply to the following browser versions: Internet Explorer® 11 (Compatibility mode off), Mozilla Firefox® (version 38.1.1) and Google Chrome™ (version 48).

Retirement of the 2000-Character File Format as an Option for Exporting Data

Effective July 14, 2016, the 2000-character file format will be retired as an option for exporting data from Document Certification. The MISMO XML file format remains as the only option for custodians to export, also providing maximum flexibility including expanded character lengths and enhanced formatting.
