



# Bulletin

## Consolidated Technology Guide

This Bulletin is issued in accordance with the section of the Consolidated Technology Guide (the “**Guide**”) entitled *Notification of Changes and Updates*. The purpose of this Bulletin is to notify Licensees that a new version of the Guide has been published that supersedes and replaces the prior version of the Guide. This version of the Guide contains updates to the Software Subscription Agreement terms and conditions.

In addition to minor clerical and clean-up edits, including typo corrections, renumbering of sections, reformatting and other similar modifications, the updated Guide includes the following substantive changes:

Part A, General Terms and Conditions

3.—Grant of Rights and Imposition of Restrictions and Obligations	Section entitled “Extraterritorial Use” was updated to specify that Licensee must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ comply with all registration requirements prescribed by a foreign jurisdiction’s regulators; and</li> <li>➤ if applicable, obtain consent from Authorized Users in foreign jurisdictions to collect their personal information in connection with using a Licensed Application.</li> </ul>

<b>Single-Family Servicing Applications</b>	PART I 1. —Licensed Application	Business Solutions Builder and Master Servicing Portfolio Manager were added as Licensed Applications.
	2. —Extraterritorial Use	Provision was updated to permit a Licensee to access and use Licensed Materials or data contained in, or generated by, the Licensed Applications listed in Part I of the Schedule through its Authorized Users located in the Philippines.
	PART II 3. —Extraterritorial Use	Provision was updated to permit a Licensee to access and use Licensed Materials or data contained in, or generated by, the Licensed Application listed in Part II of the Schedule through its Authorized Users located in the Philippines.

Also, the Software Subscription License, which together with the General Terms and Conditions and all applicable Schedules make up the Software Subscription Agreement, was revised to accommodate electronic acknowledgement by Licensee and collect point of contact information.

All changes described above are effective as of the Effective Date indicated on the first page of this Bulletin, except for (1) those pertaining to Business Solutions Builder, which are effective immediately, in accordance with the Section of the General Terms and Conditions entitled “Issued Bulletins; Amendments” and (2) those pertaining to Master Servicing Portfolio Manager, which will become effective on June 4. All other terms and conditions of the Software Subscription Agreement shall continue in full force and effect. If there is any inconsistency between or among the provisions contained in the Guide and this Bulletin, the provisions of the Guide will govern.
