INFORMATION SECURITY AND BUSINESS RESILIENCY SUPPLEMENT

This Bulletin is issued in accordance with the section of the Fannie Mae Information Security and Business Resiliency Supplement (the “**Supplement**”) entitled *General Requirements, Issued Bulletins; Amendments*. The purpose of this Bulletin is to notify Companies (Single-Family Lenders and Multifamily Lenders) currently subject to the Supplement that a new version of the Supplement has been published that supersedes and replaces the prior version of the Supplement.

In addition to minor clerical and clean-up edits, including typo corrections, renumbering of sections, reformatting and other similar modifications, the updated Supplement includes the following substantive changes:

2 - Definitions	Updated definition of the term “Company”
	Added the terms and corresponding definitions of: Integration Agreement, Requirements for Document Custodians; and, Underlying Agreements.
3.3 – Audit and Accountability	Clarified the independent security assessment requirement, removing the requirement that the independent assessor not be affiliated with the Company
4.3 – Additional Company Requirements	Updated to add Company as the responsible party for all Losses arising from a Cybersecurity Incident.
6 – General Requirements	Updated “Issued Bulletins; Amendments” to broaden Lender Contract to Underlying Agreements and scope of the Supplement and its Amendments
	Clarified language for acceptance of any bulletin amending the Supplement’s terms
	Updated the “Conflicts” section to broaden the scope of the Supplement, referencing Underlying Agreements

All changes described above are effective as of the Effective Date indicated in this Bulletin, in accordance with the Section of the Supplement entitled *General Requirements, Issued Bulletins; Amendments*. All other terms and conditions of the Supplement shall continue in full force and effect.
